

Nine Pumps Delivered In Seven Days...During Holidays

It was late December, 2005. David A. Hardesty, HVAC Project Manager for W.W. Gay Mechanical Contractor, Inc., had a Flagler College chiller plant renovation that required nine pumps to be delivered during the holidays. Specified pumps did not have a flange for the pump support, and they could not be delivered within the required construction schedule. Other manufacturers were contacted. None could furnish or build the required pumps in the limited time, except Patterson. The Toccoa, GA-based manufacturer delivered nine Pro-Max® vertical in-line pumps in seven days. Slipping comfortably into a limited footprint in the existing equipment room, the nine vertical pumps are on the job pumping primary and secondary chilled water, condenser water and hot loop water. FAMED PONCE DE LEON HOTEL

The centerpiece of the Flagler College campus, the hotel was built in 1888 by oil magnate and railroad pioneer, Henry Morrison Flagler, in a Spanish Renaissance Revival style designed by John Carrere and Thomas Hastings. Louis C. Tiffany decorated the interior with stained glass, mosaics, terra cotta relief on walls and ceilings and grand murals. Its style strongly influenced the architecture of southern Florida for over 50 years.
